



As the Director of Juvenile Services for the Dallas County Juvenile Department, Mr. Griffiths is responsible for the Agency's operation, including Juvenile Board/Commissioners Court interaction, Fiscal Management, Planning, Research, Facility Development, Program Expansion, and Public Relations. Mr. Griffiths directs department staff to accomplish mandates of Title III of the Texas Family Code involving services for delinquent and pre-delinquent youth, their families and victims of juvenile crime. The Agency services 11,000 families annually, employing 1100 employees. Department services include six Residential Programs, nine Satellite Field Probation Offices, an open enrollment Charter School, Juvenile Justice Alternative Education Program and Comprehensive Psychological / Substance Abuse services. Mr. Griffiths has been in his current position since 1995. Mr. Griffiths was previously the Chief Juvenile Probation Officer in Nueces County, Texas. Mr. Griffiths received his Bachelors Degree from Sam Houston State University and his Masters Degree in Public Administration from Texas Christian University.
